In a beautiful valley near St Tropez, this new trail traces a route via 40 works of art. It was opened in 2015 by Jean-Gabriel Mitterrand - nephew of the former French president and a gallery owner in Paris's Marais district for more than 30 years - and is one of several sculpture parks in the area, including Chateau La Coste, Commanderie de Peyrassol and Foundation Venet. The park is currently open until mid October and admission is free, though potential visitors must register online prior to their trip.
